



Why Women's Ministries?



Although it's not necessary to establish a formal women's ministry, ministry by women for women does have certain unique and positive attributes:














God has/is/will continue to call women to be His co-laborers in the gospel.

Thank Offering

"Whatever you do in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him."

-Colossians 3:17

What is a Thank Offering? Whenever we are thankful for something in our daily lives and we want to thank God in a tangible way, we place a few coins in our Thank Offering Barrel and pray a prayer of thanksgiving. This daily act of worship was established by Grace Pierson, the founder of Churches of God Women's Ministries (formerly known as Women's Christian Service Council) in 1952. The offering is then collected by local Women's Ministries groups the first Sunday in the month of May. Oftentimes a special Women's Ministries worship service is presented by the women of the congregation. The offering is then sent to the regional treasurer. The regional treasurer will send 60% of the Thank Offering to the General Conference Women's Ministries and the 40% remaining will be dispersed as decided by each region. For individuals that are not a part of a Women's Ministries group, they may send their offerings to their regional treasurer or to the CGWM treasurer, Nancy Scott. As of 2018 there have been over 2 million dollars given through the Thank Offering. Labels for your Thank Offering container are available on the website.

Uluberia Girls School

The Churches of God are embarking on a new ministry that will change the lives of girls and women in Uluberia, India. In March 2019, we opened a girls school for 5th graders. There are plans to add a grade every year through the 8th grade. Other than this school, girls finish their formal education by completing the 4th grade. The underprivileged girls who will attend the school will be given a brighter future. The school will give opportunity to teach the girls about Jesus and open doors to share with their families the love of Christ.

Women's Leadership Development

Physical Therapy School Haiti

The Physical Therapy Program in Haiti is located just outside of St. Marc, in the Lois Habecker School building. This is a new frontier, as this is the first Haitian led physical therapy program in the country! The first cohort of students started in the fall of 2015. Those who complete the four year program will have earned a bachelor's degree.

Our Thank Offerings will help female students achieve their educational goals. They are devoted and are working against great odds to finish school and begin a successful practice. They are very bright and capable students.

Venezuela Bible School

The church conference runs what we call a 3 year Bible program at the main church in San Juan de los Morros Venezuela. It is for pastors or leaders. This school is implemented at churches to prepare leaders for ministry. Venezuela has their own Conference that oversees this ministry.

The Conference is registered as a non profit with the Government of Venezuela. Each location has their own teachers and students. Thank Offering will assist women students achieve their God calling by assisting them with their educational expenses. This is especially important for them now during the current financial and economic crisis in Venezuela. The program is similar to the Pastoral Training Institute or a 4 year Bible Institute.
